Change of Location for Harrison County DSNAP Applications

(GULFPORT, MS)— Due to the large volume of Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program applicants in Harrison County, the DSNAP application location has been changed from the Mississippi Department of Human Services Harrison County Office on Larkin Smith Drive to the Mississippi Gulf Coast Coliseum and Convention Center located at 2350 Beach Blvd, Biloxi, MS 39531. Current SNAP recipients in Harrison County who suffered damage or loss due to the hurricane may be eligible for replacement SNAP with proof of loss and should file an affidavit at the Coliseum.

DSNAP applications for Hancock, Jackson and Pearl River County residents will continue to be taken at the county MDHS offices. Also, current SNAP recipients in these three counties who suffered damage or loss due to the storm may be eligible for replacement SNAP with proof of loss and should go to their MDHS county office by September 8 to file an affidavit.
